Dear Saints of Grace:



To everything there is a season...

As we move into a new spring, the Easter season and the time of planting and growth, we are challenged by God to use our talents to show off his love. Show it to be abundant. Show it to be for all people. Show it to be generous beyond human conception.

Spring doesn't happen overnight. First you see hints of the crocuses, then a tiny shoot from a daffodil. Then the tulips. Then the peonies,

then the lilacs. Each in their own time. Slowly revealing their part in God's spectacular creation.

Grace is also not fully springing back from the era of the pandemic. But we are emerging. We are adapting. We are changing, even as we hold strongly to our core belief that God loves the whole creation and that we can respond to that love by caring for each other and the rest of creation.

In the last three years, Grace has made tremendous progress in creating a quality hybrid worship experience that values both those present in worship and those joining by Zoom. We have experimented and we will continue to experiment with better ways to include those who join by Zoom within the on-site worship community. Our Technology Team will try several solutions and then will ask for feedback both from those on-line and those present in worship. As we build a consensus around a particular proposal, we will seek funding from one or more memorials. In the meantime, I'd like to offer a few Zoom etiquette tips:

- Please be sure your microphone is muted unless you have a speaking part in the service
- If you have your camera turned on, please be aware that folks present in worship can see you!
- If you choose not to activate your camera, please consider substituting a photo of yourself for the benefit of those in worship. If you need help with this process, please contact Michael Drelicharz for technical assistance.

A major way in which Grace can express God's love for the world and our part in the care of creation is our LIVING GREEN EXPO II, that will take place on Saturday, May 20, from 10am to 2pm. There will be green-themed activities for all ages AND LOTS OF OPPORTUNITY FOR VOLUNTEERS! Watch the weekly announcements for more details. I plan now to participate!

I wish you a meaningful Holy Week and Easter experience, and I look forward to our work together to show the world the self-giving love of Christ!

Council Highlights from the February 28, 2023 meeting

- Officers elected: President Dan Reimann, Vice President Mike Drelicharz, Treasurer Wendy Thompson, Financial Secretary Tom Roth, Council Secretary A.J. Mueller
- Grace has been allocated 3 voting members to attend the Chicago Metropolitan Synod Assembly held Saturday June 3
- Grace's new website is hoped to be operational by March 31
- Abt was unable to install new dishwasher due to electrical and plumbing issues.
 These are being addressed
- Easter breakfast hosted by Council start time 8:30 am.
- Approved up to \$3000 for the purchase of a new 84" TV. It will be mounted on the Sanctuary wall to the right of the altar. This will bring our Zoom worshipers into the service.
- Approved the Technology Committee to replace parts of the existing Grace Sound System with two new digital microphones, digital mixer, and digital speakers for outside/Charter Hall for up to \$5000. Request Technology committee work with Finance Committee to use existing funds.
- Information was presented to Council about the Reconciling in Christ process. This issue was raised by Mike Pirron at the annual meeting. Preliminary discussion of who would lead the process (Outreach and Welcome committees or form an Ad Hoc committee) and what any results would entail (mostly signage)
- Annual bake sale will be held on Mother's Day May 14

Council Highlights from the March 21, 2023 meeting

- Mike Pirron led a discussion on Reconciling in Christ. This is the process of creating a place of acceptance and safety for all and affirming such.
- Approved 3 Grace voting members to attend the Chicago Metropolitan Synod Assembly to be held Saturday, June 3, 2023: Mike Pirron, Cindy Pirron and a person to be named later by the Grace Congregational president.
- New dishwasher installer was unable to complete the installation due to plumbing and electrical issues. These issues will have to be addressed before the installation can be completed.
- Approved the Lenten Self Denial offering will be donated to Lutheran Disaster Response.
- Agreed to delay the purchase of a new 84" TV for the Sanctuary wall to allow for further study to optimize the Sunday service experience.
- Next meeting 4-25-23 at 7:00pm.


