

Council Highlights from the June 27, 2023 Meeting.

- The sanctuary sound system and zoom church service continue to be tweaked to improve their quality.
- Motion approved to cover the cost of a van rental up to \$300.00 for La Trinidad congregation to participate in the Wednesday Night Life on July 26.
- Wednesday Night Live in August will be on the 30th.
- Motion approved to invite Thrivent to give a presentation to Grace after the church service on September 24th. Sandwiches will be provided in conjunction with the discussion.
- Reconciling in Christ update Ad Hoc Group is forming. Surveys of our congregation are ongoing. Cynthis Lauletta has agreed to represent Council on the Ad Hoc Group.
- Joy Medrano suggested that the Grace Church facility would be ideal as a Red Cross emergency shelter. A.J. Mueller floated the idea to Council to see if there was interest in pursuing this idea. A.J. will invite Joy to the August Council meeting to provide more information about this.
- Church Council will again be sponsoring Rally Day on September 10th.


